They receive the caterpillar in a plastic container that is full of food ready for them to eat. As the caterpillar eats they grow larger and make their way to the top of the container where they form a protective cocoon around themselves and become a chrysalis. The lid is taken off and the chrysalis are then placed in a larger, butterfly safe container. After a few days the butterflies will emerge from their cocoons and fly around their protective enclosure. The children will then feed them fresh fruit and watch them grow and fly until the day of their release. This is such a wonderful tradition at New Fountain that the children truly enjoy, along with the congregation. This is a beautiful reminder of Jesus' unconditional love. A symbol of change, the butterfly represents the transformation that one experiences when they come to Christ.
